Snow lovers from all over head to this 600-acre resort on the Green Mountain State's highest southern peak.

The White Stuff Stratton gets an average of 15 feet of snow annually across its 92 trails and seven terrain parks. Alpine, Nordic, cross-country and adaptive (for the disabled) skiing

are all on the menu, as are tubing, ice-skating and snowmobiling. Catch the last full-moon snowshoe hike of the season on March 19, topped off with s'mores and hot chocolate. Kids will love the mini-snowmobile rides on weekends and holidays, and teens can refine their skills with group snowboarding lessons. Don't miss seeing the pros at the U.S. Open Snowboarding Championships from March 7 to 13.

Off Slope Exercise your shopping skills at Stratton Village Square or the designer outlets in nearby Manchester, also home to the Southern Vermont Arts Center and Hildene, the estate of presidential son Robert Todd Lincoln. Or check out Manchester's maple-sugaring celebration March 19 to 20.
